

LEITZELL FAMILY FOUNDATION AGRICULTURAL/HORTICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

It is the intent of the scholarship to provide financial aid to any individual from the Mercer County, Ohio region who shows continuous interest and enthusiasm in the field of agriculture or horticulture. Such interest should be manifested through active participation in such programs as 4-H, FFA, Scouts, etc., and continued into secondary education in appropriate career oriented programs.

This student need not be the highest scholastic achiever, but should have a strong foundation in agriculture/horticulture. The applicant should demonstrate a determined and enthusiastic desire and drive to achieve in this area.

The eligible undergraduate must be a graduating high school senior and show financial need as determined by the scholarship committee.

Once first round candidates have been selected, personal interviews will be required. Recommendations of the review committee will be based on both personal interview and written application responses. All applicants are to be screened by your review committee for worthiness, completeness, and to insure they are within the parameters of our foundation philosophy. The review committee will then consult with the Board of Directors of the Leitzell Family Foundation before the recipient is selected and announced. The Board of the Foundation has absolute discretion in selecting the recipient of the award from among the finalists. Historically, our scholarships range from \$1500.00 to \$3000.00. The scholarship is for tuition/related academic expenses. The scholarship may be renewable based on college transcripts and a submitted renewal application. The recipient must maintain at least a 2.75 cumulative grade point average on a 4.00 scale for renewal.

Completed application must be returned to the applicant's high school guidance office. The guidance office is to mail the applications in triplicate **for receipt no later than March 1st** to the Foundation.
