Our agency is a private, outpatient clinic which provides individual, family, marital and some group psychological services. Other specific services include consulting, psychological testing and chemical dependency evaluations and treatment. We provide services to children (minimum age 4), adolescents and adults. There are four therapists and three secretaries on our staff. We are a pro-life, pro-family agency that provides clinical services within a Christian perspective. We now have two office locations. Our main office remains in Celina. In addition, Dr. Oswalt provides services in St. Marys on Thursdays at the Wheatland Building across from the hospital on Knoxville Avenue.

PSYCHOLOGIST – Crystal L. Oswalt, Ph.D. – Doctorate and Master's degrees in Clinical Psychology from the California School of Professional Psychology, and undergraduate degree completed at Ohio State University, Columbus, Ohio.
